^{*}Among the optional courses, a minimum of 15 HEC within the main field of the specialisation (Applied English linguistics) is required and a minimum of 15 HEC should be taken within another field. Selection of optional courses is done in consultation with the contact persons for the programme (see below). Studies should also include two practically oriented courses (one being English for Academic Research, which can be taken in Aug-Oct or Nov-Jan in year 2).

The optional courses for 2016 are to be confirmed. Courses usually offered at the Department of English are: English as a Lingua Franca, Sociolinguistics, Pragmatics, World Englishes, Phonetics / Phonology, Old English, Middle English, Semantics, and Syntax.

Applications to courses (apart from those in the first term) at the Department of English should be made through www.antagning.se ahead of each term. Deadline for applications to courses in the spring is 15 October and 15 April for courses in the autumn. For optional courses within another field, please consult the department in question regarding the application process.
