

## Dear Master students in Applied English Linguistics,

The academic and administrative staff in the Department of English at Stockholm University wish to welcome you to the Master's Programme in Language Sciences (Applied English Linguistics, 120 credits). This Master's programme is a collaboration mainly between the Department of Linguistics and the Department of English. Most of the courses you will take belong to one of these Departments. We sincerely hope that you will enjoy your two years of studies with us, and that you will find the courses stimulating and challenging.

In your first autumn semester you will take four obligatory courses:

Language in Use (7.5 credits)
 Scientific Method and Research Ethics (7.5 credits)
 Language Learning and Second Language Acquisition (7.5 credits)
 Discourse Analysis (7.5 credits)

The programme starts with the first two of these courses, which are taken by all students in the Master's Programmes in Language Sciences. The course 'Language in Use' is given by the <a href="Department of Linguistics">Department of Linguistics</a> and the course 'Scientific Method and Research Ethics' by the <a href="Department of Philosophy">Department of Philosophy</a>. You will find information for these courses on their departmental websites.

The courses 'Language Learning and Second Language Acquisition' and 'Discourse Analysis', which begin in November, are given by the Department of English. You will find information and schedules for our courses on our Departmental website.
