



# The 2013 Metaphor Festival

## Department of English, Stockholm University

### How to get there

Arriving by air: From Arlanda airport, take the airport train (Arlanda Express) to the Central Station in Stockholm (one way SEK 260, return 490; online booking at <http://www.arlandaexpress.se>), or the airport coach to the “City terminal” across the street from the Central Station (one way SEK 99, return SEK 198; online booking at <http://www.flygbussarna.se>).

Arriving by train: The train will take you to the Central Station.

Proceeding from the Central Station area:

1. You can take a taxi from outside the station (about SEK 200). Beware of illegal taxi drivers, whose cabs are not marked in any way. Choose a cab from “Taxi Stockholm” or “Taxi Kurir”. Tell the driver you are going to the University at Frescati, taxi stop 2, Universitetsvägen (outside the A building). It may be a good idea to print the map on the next page and show it to the driver. Enter the main building (Södra huset) through the door labelled A.
2. You can take the underground from the station called “T-Centralen” (marked by a blue T in a white circle) adjacent to the Central Station (SEK 44).<sup>\*</sup> You take train 14 bound for Mörby Centrum (on the red line). The trains run every ten minutes. Get off at station “Universitetet”, take the escalator up to the ground level and take the footpath that leads to Bloms hus (blue arrow on the maps on pp. 2 and 3). Continue past Bloms hus (on your right), turn right and enter the main building (Södra huset) through the door labelled C.

Proceeding from your hotel:

If you have arrived the day before and are setting out for the Festival from your hotel, please note the following:


1. If you are staying at the Best Western TIME HOTEL, you may wish to take bus 40 to the university. If you do, please note that you must buy a ticket before you board the bus. The bus stop is called “Universitetet Södra”; the footpath from there to the university buildings is marked with a yellow arrow on the map on p. 3. You enter the building through door A.
2. If you choose to go by underground, ask the reception clerk for directions to the nearest station. If that station is not on the red line, take a train to one of the stations “Slussen”, “Gamla stan” or “T-Centralen”. Change there to a train on line 14 bound for Mörby Centrum. The trains run every ten minutes (less frequently on Saturday morning). Get off at station “Universitetet”, take the escalator up to the ground level and take the footpath that leads to Bloms hus (blue arrow on the maps on pp. 3 and 4). Continue past Bloms hus (on your right), turn right and enter the main building (Södra huset) through the door labelled C.


#### Inside the university building:

If you have entered through door A from the taxi stop, follow the yellow arrow on p. 4 along the main corridor until you reach lecture hall F11 at the far end, where you will see the registration tables. If you have entered through door C from the underground station, go downstairs inside the entrance, turn left in the main corridor and go to the far end.

#### Points to note:

- It is recommended that you do your currency change at the airport or at the Central Station in Stockholm.
- There is a cash machine in “Allhuset” on campus, another one at the underground station “Universitetet” marked by green four-point stars on the map on p. 3 (.
