



IT Resources at the Festival

Presentations:

- **Presentations.** All lecture halls and session rooms are equipped with a PC and laser canon (beamer). *All you need is a USB or CD*.
 - Before your presentation session starts, please check with the session chairperson to add your PowerPoint etc. to the computer's desktop.
 - You can also run your presentation directly from your USB, but sometimes the computer must be rebooted in order to find the memory stick, and that wastes valuable session time.
- Your own computer. You can also use your own PC or Mac for the presentation.
 - o Mac users, please note that you will need the appropriate Mac adaptor for the standard RGB 15-pin input from your Mac to the beamer.
- **Internet access.** The session room PC has access to the Internet; to get your PC onto the net during your presentation, use a wifi connection.
- **Power** (220v, 50-60 cycles) is available from (northern European- or Europlug) outlets along the windows in the session rooms; the plenary rooms are very poorly equipped for power outlets, and you'll need to use a battery.

Wireless connections (there are several options):

- **Eduroam** at SU is freely available to scholars and students at all European universities that have implemented it—to use it, you should preconfigure your laptop and *activate it at your home university before coming to the Festival*. See http://www.eduroam.org/ for information and safe log-ins. Be warned, however, that it apparently still doesn't always work!
- **Guest log-ins**. We can provide you with a guest log-in, but make sure that your laptop is patched up-to-date!
- **Commercial wifi** is available throughout the Stockholm region, but make sure you have an international connection for your service.

E-mail:

- **Hotels:** Most Stockholm hotels now provide an Internet connection, but you may be charged a fee. Check with your hotel ahead of time.
- Wireless services are the best bet, and are always available at SU.
- **Dept. PCs** are available in a crisis, but please do not count on using them.
